We received your most appreciated letter for which we thank you ever so much, including this sheet of paper and stamps.

We haven't the slightest idea why Annie's letters came to the Empire Hotel as we addressed them on "General Delivery" - but thanks just the same for notifying us.

We're all fine and O.K. as usual. Hope you're still in a better condition. But tho' we're all fine and healthy there's so much work to do that keeps us busy every time of the minute.

We are enclosing your "Barbar Tools" with this letter and hope they arrive safely.

The weather here is very nice and sunny & dry. The farmers are going to cut grain next week.

On August 4-5, there was sports at Ryecroft, and talk about the big crowd! (there was.) He attended one day, Mother, Dad, Nancy. But Jack & Donald (Victoria) were both days as the Greenway Soft Ball Girls played Soft Ball and I was in the team.

We played ball with Wankam big 6 ft tall ladies and won from them. Then we played with Prestville Juniors & won from them and lastly played with Spirit River and won from them. So we were the winners of the day and got \$15.00 for each child. So I got \$1.50 too.

To morrow we're going to play with Spirit Valley the price is \$0.00

and I hope we get it, because  
once before we played with  
them and we beat them and had  
to get \$5.00 but they only gave us  
\$2.50 and all of us <sup>paid</sup> ~~paid~~ at the gate  
25¢

On 8 of Aug. there was a man by  
the name of A. J. Ody who come to "Educational  
Hall" (L. Temple) & he was showing all  
kinds of magic tricks to the people.  
Of course the people had to pay  
to get in the hall. This man travels  
all over the world. Maybe you know  
him.

might come home on 13 of Aug or 14 and  
she's going to teach in Greenway School  
again.

father came to Ryecroft about  
2 weeks ago. (over.)
