RULES AND REGULATIONS

Each student must recognize that individual liberties in an institution such as ours, must of necessity be governed by a concern for liberty of others. The welfare of the students of the Institute as a whole, is the object of these rules.

- 1. Do unto others as you would have them do unto you.
- 2. It is expected that each student take part in the cultural-educational program in the Institute.
- 3. Possession of intoxicants is forbidden in all public areas of the building.
- 4. Gambling of any kind is not permitted in the Institute.
- 5. Silence will be maintained in the dormitories from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. This is the study and sleeping period for all students and consideration will be expected at all times. All public areas will be quiet from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m..
- 6. Each student is expected to attend the church of his or her choice on Sunday.
- 7. All student activities held in St. John's Institute must be approved by the Rector well in advance.
- 8. Guest for meals or overnight guests must have advance approval of the Rector.
- 9. No visitors allowed in the Institute after 11:00 p.m.
- 10. Dress for all meals during the week should be neat. No food or beverage shall be taken from the dining room after any meal or coffee break.
- 11. All entrance doors shall be locked at 11:30 p.m..
- 12. Students are obliged to conduct themselves honorably and with decorum at all times within and outside the Institute.
- 13. Intervisitation is permitted only at certain specified hours of the day.

ROOM RULES

- 1. Each student is responsible for his room and chattels therein and will be charged for any damage caused. A room inspection form will be sighned by the student upon receiving his key. It is not permissible to use TAPE, NAILS, PINS, TACKS, ETC. on walls or woodwork.
- 2. All radio and/or record players shall be played low to avoid disturbing anyone else. Televisions are not allowed in the rooms.

- 3. Each student is responsible for the neatness and cleanliness of his or her room and for making of his bed in the morning.
- 4. Damages to the building or removal of any chattels therein by students, but not attributable to any one student or group of students, may be charged to (a) the entire student body; (b) the girls only; (c) the boys only; depending on the location of the damage.
- 5. Each student is required to serve a month's notice of intention to vacate the room during the year and such notice shall be in writing on or before the firs- day of the month. Without such notice, the student shall be charged a month's rent.

Infraction of any rule will be sufficient cause for fine, suspension or immediate expulsion from residence.
