Dear John;

We have received your letter quite a while ago for which we thank you very much. We are very sorry to not have answered you quicker but as you know for yourself how busy everyone is in late spring. Well, how are you getting along? very well we hope. We are all as well as usual. We have finished spring work two weeks ago and now making summer fallow. We have finished hoeing our garden for the first term and soon will have to hoe for the second term. Our garden is growing quite nicely and so is the grain quite big. We have rains quite frequently and lots of warm sunny days. We did not take any clucking hens from you because by the time we received an answer we didn't need any and also they were not trying to set as Mrs. Delly had them shut until not long ago Mike Katak took them on your farm. He lives on your farm already making summer fallow. He has built a shack there too. We have more chickens now than we had last year. We have over 200 chickens; 2 turkeys; 40 ducks and 6 geese. We have black

colt named "Star" and Annie has a
little calf with white head named "Patch"
Annie is going to Edmonton to-night
same time as this letter so perhaps
you might see her in Edmonton. ~~Over~~
School is over. Victoria passed and so did
(2) Nancy to Grade nine. Annie made
a real nice Ukrainian concert on
19th of June. Boy it sure was nice.
Everyone liked it. We had Ukrainian
dances and songs & Orchestra. There was
a picnic on June 28th at Szarnecki's farm.
It wasn't so good as it was quite
cold so many people didn't attend it.
Why do you always say such things
against the municipal when the
municipal helps you a whole lot. It
send you to the hospital and now pays
75¢ for you daily for that that you
are staying there. It helps you a lot
doesn't it. How long do you intend
to stay there? and when do you
intend to come back on your farm?
Do you intend to stay there? And how
is your health now. There is also
Mrs. Shomanka in Edmonton. She went
to see the doctor that helped Mrs. Bzawy.
Did you see her? Also Steve Didow
went to see this doctor. Perhaps
you've heard of him. He learned his
doctor work from practice or something
but everyone is interested in him.
We have one more member by the
name of Mrs. Bill's name that is

Sophie Kuderna had a little son.
Also Mrs. John Glowasky had
a little girl. We know ourselves
that you haven't money and
that it is pretty bad but we
are very sorry we can't help
as almost everyone is about
broke at this time of year. Well
there are no more news to
write so will close.
